

WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION **NOTICE**

The Town of Brunswick Water Department will be installing a new valve in the 16-inch water main servicing the Brunswick Pump Station on North Lake Avenue. This work will be done on Friday October 25th 2024 from 9:00 am to approximately 3:00 PM. This will require a temporary interruption in the water service to your home. As a precaution it is recommended that you boil your water used for cooking and drinking until Monday October 28th. See the Town web site for more information.

The Water Department of the Town of Brunswick apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause our customers. Please set aside water for drinking and flushing your facilities as required.

There will also be the potential for the water to be discolored from disturbed iron sediments in the water line. Please check your water before doing laundry for discoloration. Flush your water pipes either through a hose spigot or your bathtub faucet.

If you should experience reduced water pressure in your water faucets after water service has been restored, check all faucets by removing the water saver and protective screen on the faucet and rinse out the line, reinstall the water saver and screen after the line has been run for a few minutes. Sediment caught in the screen is the most common cause for reduced water pressure in your home.
