Supervisor Herrington called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold a Public Hearing to accept public comment on Introductory Local Law No. 1 of 2023 extending a moratorium on the filing, acceptance, review, or determination of any land use or application pertaining to commercial solar collector systems.

At Supervisor Herrington's request, the Deputy Town Clerk read the complete Notice of Public Hearing into record. The Notice had been posted on the Town website, the Town Hall bulletin board and published in The Eastwick Press.

VISITORS WHO WISH TO SPEAK:

Jim Tkacik, 387 Brunswick Road, wants to know what has been done in the past year related to commercial solar. Supervisor Herrington responded he has seen the consultant's report in its draft form and once it is finalized it will be made available to the public. Councilman Christian reassured Mr. Tkacik the board has been working diligently throughout the past year. He stated the board is depending on expert opinions and will consider what is best for the Town when the reports are complete.
