**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**Introductory Local Law No. 3 of the Year 2024**

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that there has been introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Brunswick, New York, a proposed local law entitled “A Local Law Amending Section 139-3 of the Town Code of the Town of Brunswick so as to Extend the Eligibility for the Senior Citizens Tax Exemption in the Town of Brunswick” and designated as Introductory Local Law No. 3 of the Year 2024. The purpose of this proposed introductory local law is to make the Senior Citizens Tax Exemption on real property in the Town of Brunswick, as provided for in Article I of Chapter 139 of the Town Code of the Town of Brunswick, available to additional taxpayers, as is authorized by New York State Real Property Tax Law, Section 467, as currently amended.
