The purpose of the meeting was to hold a Public Hearing to accept public comment regarding Introductory Local Law No. 5 of the Year 2024 entitled "A Local Law Establishing the Residency Requirements for the Appointed Office of Town Attorney of the Town of Brunswick", and designated as Introductory Local Law No. 5 of the Year 2024. The purpose of this proposed introductory local law is to supersede and amend Town Law §23.1(a) and Public Officers Law §3, and §30.1.d so as to provide that the person appointed to and holding the office of Town Attorney of the Town of Brunswick need not be a resident nor an elector of the Town of Brunswick, provided that such person is a resident and elector of the County of Rensselaer, State of New York, or any county in New York State adjoining Rensselaer County.

At Supervisor Herrington's request, the Town Clerk read the complete Notice of Public Hearing into record. The Notice had been posted on the Town website, the Town Hall bulletin board and published in The Eastwick Press.
